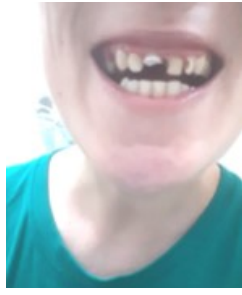
help Ukrainians who are simply transiting, we don't have the time to meet their needs. Instead we are looking for a group who will stay longer term and take care of themselves. Then we will make available the middle floor of the Foundation building. There is also opportunity to support volunteer drivers from Teiuş and aid deliveries from Alba Iulia [below].
